I am objecting to the application for licences to allow the playing of recorded music and the supply of alcohol. I live in the flat above said premises and have already had many problems with noise late into the night, from people within and people leaving the premises. The owner has changed from a Take away to a full restaurant with approximately fifteen placements and wishes to play music and serve alcohol. I feel this will and has already increased the noise levels particularly the music which has been played at high volume. In my bed room the sound is so high it is as if it is being played in the room. I understand to make an objection I have to give my reasons with in one of the four licensing objectives.

- **The prevention of crime and disorder**

There are already several premises which supply alcohol with in the vicinity of the said address, two of which are public houses, when these premises close at night there has been in the past instances of damage to property and vehicles and fighting in the street. If this address has a licence as well I feel this could add to the potential damage and disorder.

Littering is already a problem along this part of Imperial Ave, I have now noticed an increased number cigarette butts outside the said premises and more take away and drink packaging.

- **Public safety**

The speakers which have been fitted in the address above are flush fitting into the ceiling. To make them flush fitting they have had to cut a hole in the ceiling which in

turn has broken the fire barrier between the restaurant and my flat causing potential safety risk to my self and my wife in the event of a fire.

Smoking is not allowed on the said premises so smokers tend to gather outside the front of the restaurant or just at the side of the restaurant which is the access to my front door, both areas are directly below my bedroom windows. Smoke travels up into my bedroom if my windows are open.


- **Prevention of public nuisance**

As above the noise of the music being played from the restaurant below is so loud that it is as if we have our own music playing. There is no insulation in the ceiling to floor void so even the people talking can be heard from below. This is impacting on our health as we are not getting rest from the noise and disruption from below.

Smokers gather outside the access to my front door.

I hope you take all of my points into account. I feel that if the licences are granted it will defiantly have an affect on the quality of mine and my wife's life. We are both in full time employment and do not want to be kept awake until 11pm or later by music or people talking within or just outside the premises. I hope to hear from you soon regarding this matter.
