Supporting information from Applicant

- 1. An e-mail form the Applicant was received on 04/06/2020 stating that the information contained within the Officers report (paragraphs 5.1.8-5.1.16), with regards to the river related use of part of the site for boatbuilding and repairs, is incorrect.
