554. CHAIRMAN'S NOTICES

The Chairman welcomed everyone present and went through some general housekeeping arrangements for the meeting.

555. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies of absence were received from Councillors M G Bassenger and N J Skeens.

556. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

RESOLVED that the Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 28 October 2021 be approved.

557. DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST

There were none.

558. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There was none.

559. MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

The Committee received the report of the Director of Service Delivery reporting the progress of activities undertaken by Maldon Community Safety Partnership (CSP) since the last meeting held on 28 October 2021.

The most recent Essex Police performance summary (to 31 January 2022) was attached as Appendix 1 to the report. An update following the re-election of Roger Hirst as Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner (PFCC) was provided along with details of the ongoing work to support related work.

Members noted the continued good work of the CSP and the liaison it had with Essex Police and other statutory partners. The current Maldon CSP Plan on a Page for 2021 / 22 was attached as Appendix 2.

The Community Safety Manager provided Members with an update on a number of areas related to the Partnership set out in the report. Members' attention was drawn to the Essex Violence and Vulnerability Unit and it was noted that the full funding for this work would be received from the Home Office for the following year.

In response to questions raised, Officers provided the Committee with the following information:

- In response to comments about drug dealing, Members were reminded to report any activities observed to the Police or Community Protection Team. Receipt of such information was of great importance so that the Police could respond accordingly, for example by directing patrols into the area, executing warrants etc. Members were advised that there had been a number of operations undertaken following receipt of community intelligence which had resulted in arrests and recovery of drugs.
- There would be a Community Engagement Event taking place on 8 April 2022 at the Promenade Park. A number of partner organisations would be attending and the event would enable the public to come and chat with partners and also assist in identifying any areas where improvements could be made etc.
 Members were encouraged to attend this event, further details of which would be forthcoming.
- The work to engage with young people was highlighted including reference to a listening project carried out for the last three years by Essex voluntary Service for Young People. The project engaged with young persons to identify their concerns and what they wanted e.g. more street lighting and provisions being open later.
- Neighbourhood Watch had seen a reduction during the pandemic despite meetings being migrated to MS Teams. However, this was now increasing again and Officers were looking to schedule some face to face meetings.

The Chairman put the recommendation as set out in the report and this was duly agreed.

RESOLVED (by assent) that the current progress of the initiatives undertaken by the partnership to date be noted.

560. ROADS POLICING IN MALDON DISTRICT

The Chairman advised that this item of business would be considered next on the agenda.

The Committee received a presentation from Adam Pipe, Head of Roads Policing which informed Members of the current Roads Policing Teams and the work they undertook including those areas arising from the Force Plan and Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner's Improving Road Safety Plan.

As part of the presentation, and in response to questions, the following information was provided:

• Killed and Serious Injury Casualties (KSI) – The Maldon District had in 2021 seen an increase in casualties compared with 2020 and further breakdown of

the related figures was provided along with the common contributors. It was noted that drugs were proving a large part of road traffic fatalities and Members were provided with further statistics in relation to this area. In referencing the roads to the Dengie Mr Pipe advised that teams would be out in marked and unmarked vehicles to take positive action. Speed was the second highest contributary factor and the attraction of a market town to young drivers leading to groups of such drivers meeting were referenced. Drive by social media was a particularly difficult area to police due to its spontaneous nature, however plans were being put in place for a response procedure.

Mr Pipe referred to the huge impact on KSI and 'Vision Zero' for 2040 which would target safe roads and roadsides, safe vehicles, speeds and road use along with post collision response and case. This would involve a total change to how people used the road network and be underpinned by a safe system approach. Speed would be an important part in this, and it was noted that Essex County Council was currently updating its speed management plan. It was planned that as part of Vision Zero, Safe Roads and Safe Roadsides would look at designing out collisions and the possibility of casualties. Consideration would be needed in respect of new developments and new roads and new developments and Mr Pipe referenced average speed systems in relation to these.

 Maldon High Street / Average Speed Cameras – It was intended that Maldon High Street and Market Hill would see a reduction in speed limit to 20 Miles Per Hour (MPH). Mr Pipe advised that the enforcement of this was difficult and referred to average speed products which could assist with compliance without the need for Police intervention. The Director of Service Delivery advised that the Council was having discussions with the Police around average speed cameras and new planning developments.

At this point Mr Pipe referenced a scheme which had seen recent success in Clacton. This involved the public sending in digital images of anything on the road which was not correct. CCTV images were also used and cases being brought to court on a monthly basis.

- Updated Mobile Phone Legislation Current phone legislation was to be updated on 25 March 2022. The most significant change related to the introduction of a life term tariff for death through drink or drugs.
- Speed Management A total review of the speed management strategy was currently underway, and the new strategy would look to afford more protection on routes used by more vulnerable road user groups. Members were advised that engagement with such current groups was underway and would include the motorcycle community.
- TruCam / Speed Watch The Fire Service were leading on the Community Speed Watch initiative which now had 120 groups and 12,000 volunteers.
 Essex County Council Road Safety Officers were involved in training alongside the Fire Service and Police. Members were advised that volunteers would not be given TruCam for enforcement purposes, however an increase in resources would allow Officers to provide further assistance to such groups.
- Members were advised that the Police operated both a marked and unmarked fleet of vehicles, with these being based both at the Stanway and South Woodham Ferrers stations. Mr Pipe advised of improvements being made and investment of £1.5m within the operational policing command which included roads, dogs, armed response and noted that all cars would now be fitted with front and rear facing cameras.

 In response to a question regarding the old Police Station in Maldon, Chief Inspector Scott-Haynes advised that estate issues within Essex Police were out of his control however the old station had now been sold by Essex Police.
 Members were advised that the Police would be expanding its space at Maldon District Council offices.

Mr Pipe concluded advising that there was a lot happening in the small team, and the importance of being seen at different locations.

The Chairman thanked Mr Pipe for his informative presentation.

561. POLICE PERFORMANCE UPDATE

Chief Inspector (CI) Steve Scott-Haynes addressed the Committee and drew Members' attention to the Essex Police Performance Summary report, appended to Agenda Item 6 - Maldon District Community Safety Partnership Update.

CI Scott-Haynes provided Members with a detailed update and highlighted the following areas:

- Community Policing Team In the latest precept 78 officers were being brought into the force specifically to increase town centre teams. Maldon had been allocated five of these officers, which with current resources would now give one sergeant and six police constables to cover the whole of the District including the Dengie. In addition, Members were advised that the Police would be doubling its footprint at the Maldon District Council offices.
- Crime Crime figures had increased, although this was expected with the easing of lockdown. It was noted that the Maldon District had the second lowest crime rate (per head of capita) in Essex.
- CI Scott-Haynes referenced a number of Ongoing Operations regarding drug dealing, increasing stop and search and intel gathering. It was noted that the Maldon District was running above the national average in respect of positive stop and searches.
- Partnership working was continuing and there had been significant arrests recently in relation to home grown drugs. A day of action was being planned.
- Anti-Social Behaviour had seen an increase, but the team were working on reducing this. Some Officers had been redesignated to High Schools following concern regarding anti-vaccine protestors attending.
- A number of areas which had seen decreases in activity such as residential burglary could be related to the recent pandemic and lockdowns.
- The quarterly **confidence survey** had been carried out and was at its highest level, with 83% stating that the Police were doing a good job. However there had been a drop in the category 'feeling informed about what the Police are doing in my local area. CI Scott-Haynes advised that this meant that information was not getting reaching residents and he highlighted work being done to resolve this including newsletters and restarting coffee with cops. He informed Members that any further suggestions would be greatly received.

Following the update from CI Scott-Haynes and in response to questions from Members the following information was provided:

• In respect of racial and religiously aggravated offences Members were advised that this area had previously been under reported and the Police were now

seeing greater reporting of such offences which equated for some of the increase in this area. The Police were working to address specific issues relating to shops where shop owners had suffered abuse, in addition to developing links with the gay community.

- The Police had been working with schools, dispersal teams, etc. to not only get messages across but also re-educate people.
- Instances of Anti-Social Behaviour reported in Southminster and Bradwell had been targeted by Officers along with the Tri-Services Officer.

The Chairman referred to some questions sent by Councillor W Stamp and the Director of Service Delivery advised that he would be writing to the Chief Inspector and responding to Councillor Stamp directly regarding these.

The Chairman thanked Chief Inspector Scott-Haynes for attending the meeting and his presentation.

There being no other items of business the Chairman closed the meeting at 8.52 pm.

MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 Members are asked to note the progress of activities undertaken by the Maldon Community Safety Partnership (CSP) since the last meeting held on 10 March 2022.

2. RECOMMENDATION

That Members review and comment on the current progress of the initiatives undertaken by the partnership to date.

3. SUMMARY OF KEY ISSUES

3.1 **Statutory Duties**

- 3.1.1 Partners have agreed the priorities for 2022/23 based on the data review and risk matrix exercise. The headline priorities listed below will remain the same as the previous year with some changes to the narrative based on the impact of the pandemic and current risks. The priorities, listed below, reflect priorities already identified in the revised Police and Crime Plan, the Essex Crime Prevention Strategy, and the current Essex Police Strategic Assessment.
- 3.1.2 The current priorities are highlighted on the Maldon District Council (MDC) website. It should be noted that reducing reoffending remains a statutory function for all community safety partnerships and is embedded in the priorities listed below.
 - Tackling crime and reducing reoffending (with an emphasis on violent crime, gangs, drug trafficking and high harm offences);
 - Driving down anti-social behaviour in public places (with an emphasis on youth nuisance and improving partnership visibility);
 - Identifying and supporting vulnerable people (with an emphasis on domestic abuse, violence against women and girls, social isolation, suicide prevention, mental health and hate crime);
 - Increase confidence in identifying and reducing rural crime;
 - Promoting road safety and challenging irresponsible driving.
- 3.1.3 These priorities will contribute to the Council's Corporate Plan 2021-23 for the Community, with the goal being "Through our projects, actions, communication, partnerships and policies we will work to support our communities, the health and well-being of our residents, and to provide safe and clean places to live in and enjoy." Projects are highlighted as activities in the community safety action plan for 2022 / 23. Each activity has a clear timescale with a red, amber, green rating (RAG),

proposed financial spend and milestone to enable performance monitoring of each project associated to the activity as per recommendations of the internal audit from 2020. Activities are reported quarterly to the Responsible Authorities Group, through a finance report and monthly through the community safety partnership hub tasking meetings.

- 3.1.4 The current Essex Police Maldon performance figures for the rolling year to 31 August 2022 (compared to the same period last year) showed an increase in all crime by 8.5% (302 more offences) and a decrease in anti-social behaviour by 59.6% (700 less incidents). It should be noted that there has been an increase in all crime in Essex by 9.1% with a decrease in anti-social behaviour by 51.8%. A summary of the crime profile for Maldon will be presented at the meeting by a representative from the community policing team. A copy of the Essex Police force performance summary for the county is attached as APPENDIX 1. Whilst there has been a decrease in anti-social behaviour (ASB) reports to the police, local authority reports continue to be high which is a combination of nuisance behaviour, noise, fly tipping and neighbour disputes. The Council's Community Engagement Officers (CEOs) have been doing joint patrols with Essex Police and other agencies during these busy periods.
- 3.1.5 Officers continue to work with the Essex Police to ensure that local risks are addressed. The Community Safety Manager chairs the Essex County Prevent Group and attends the Essex Contest Board. The most recent Counter Terrorism Local Profile (CTLP) briefing (Quarter 1) was on 6 September 2022 and strategic members have been briefed on current risks. The current UK threat remains at "SUBSTANTIAL". Recent work around Prevent has included the delivery of training to schools and early years settings, delivery of training to elected members, and learning sessions on anti-minority narratives, and exploring neurodiversity. Officers continue to engage with communities through the Independent Advisory Group which meets every two months. The last meeting was held on 12 September 2022. This acts as a good forum to discuss community tensions, hate crime and policing interventions such as Stop and Search, and gives a voice to underrepresented communities. The Community Safety Manager is also a member of the Special Interest Group in Countering Extremism (SIGCE).
- 3.1.6 Forward scanning, new duties that will impact on the work of the partnership will be the Serious Violence Duty and the Protect Duty which will come into force next year. Safer Essex has agreed that all districts will work to a pan Essex duty in relation to serious violence and that the Essex Violence Reduction Unit (Essex VRU) will lead on the preparation of a local needs assessment, linking in with the Health and Wellbeing Boards and the Essex Strategic Coordination Group. The Home Office have also committed to undertake a "full review" of community safety partnerships across England and Wales, to identify how (if at all) they can increase their overall effectiveness in protecting local communities from crime and ASB. This process has been delayed whilst new ministers were put into roles in September 2022.

3.2 Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner Update

- 3.2.1 Roger Hirst was re-elected as the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner (PFCC) following an election on 6 May 2021. The partnership continues to support the priorities identified in the refreshed Police and Crime Plan which was extended until 2024. The most recent public meeting for Maldon was held on 16 May 2022 as a virtual meeting on Zoom linked with Facebook live.
- 3.2.2 Works continue with several multi-agency groups that support this work locally and across Essex. The Office of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner (OPFCC) has

confirmed that core funding for Maldon in 2022 / 23 will be £12,527 and the necessary funding forms were completed and returned as part of the funding agreement. The Essex Crime Prevention Fund will continue throughout 2022 / 23 for partnerships, charities, and community groups to access funds which support the priorities of the Police and Crime Plan. Two countywide projects that were recently approved for funding were for Cleansheet and The Children's Society. The Police, Fire and Crime Panel (PFCP) approved a further increase in the council tax precept for 2022 / 23 (4.79% or £9.99 per annum for a Band D property) for policing which will see recruitment of another 200 extra officers in 2022 / 23. There will be a small increase in the precept for fire services (1.95% or £1.44 per annum as above). The Maldon representative for the Police Fire and Crime Panel is Councillor Bruce B Heubner who is also the MDC representative for Responsible Authorities Group as agreed at the annual meeting of MDC, with Councillor Mark Heard acting as substitute.

- 3.2.3 More locally the increase in policing numbers saw the introduction of Town Centre Teams for Maldon, Chelmsford and South Woodham Ferrers, the introduction of Community Safety Engagement Officers and the reintroduction of the Marine Unit (based at Burnham-on-Crouch), Disruptor Teams established, a new Business Crime Team and the Rural Engagement Team (RET) has also doubled in size, which supports the priority of tackling rural crime and is now working very closely with the Council's Community Engagement Officers (CEOs). These new posts will see further increases in town centre and community policing teams, more officers to tackle violence in all forms, more for crime investigation and to tackle organised crime. There has been the introduction of a tri-service pilot to cover the Dengie which is an officer role funded by Essex Police, Essex County Fire and Rescue Service and East of England Ambulance Service. There was also the launch of the new initiative to patrol the coastline and waterways of Essex in July 2021 that has included the joint purchase of jet skis for officer use.
- 3.2.4 As previously reported, the Essex VRU was established with members seconded from Essex Police, Essex County Council (ECC), Youth Offending Teams (YOT) and Probation and has seen significant Home Office funding come to Essex in 2018/19, 2019/20 and 2020/21. This effective unit now has agreed funding for the next three years (until 31 March 2025) from the Home Office together with annual contributions from the PFCC and ECC. 3.3 Community Safety Partnership Hub and Progress Update

3.3.1 The Community Safety Partnership (CSP) Hub for Chelmsford and Maldon meets bimonthly and has a tasking process which links to the priorities of the CSP. Tasking has continued to use Microsoft Teams and receives good attendance from a variety of partners. The community safety team also attend fortnightly local tasking with Essex Police. There is an individual action plan for Maldon CSP plus a tasking update which is monitored to ensure that partner actions are completed and performance managed. A copy of the current Maldon CSP Plan on a Page is attached as APPENDIX 2. Subgroups of the partnership continue to meet on a regular basis and work streams for each individual group are effectively impacting on various areas of community safety. Regular attendees at tasking include council officers and CCTV staff, community policing team, ECC Youth Services and Youth Offending Services, Probation, Family Solutions, Peabody, Phoenix Futures, Children's Health & Wellbeing Service, The Children's Society, Neighbourhood Watch, Open Road, Community 360 and Social Care with other partners supporting the process when necessary (analytical support, serious organised crime, intelligence etc.). The community safety hub is occupied by Community Safety

Partnership Officers, the Community Policing Team, the Town Centre Unit, ECFRS and Mid and South Essex Integrated Care System. This has already improved joint working within the respective teams, which will provide a much better service for the public in terms of performance, visibility, and reassurance. The community policing team will also have a hub at MDC offices soon which will comprise of one sergeant and six police constables.

- Officers attend the MACE 1 and MACE 2 (Missing and Child Exploitation) meetings (27 September 2022), and the Behaviour and Attendance Partnership (BAP) on Microsoft Teams to ensure that the needs of vulnerable children for the district are addressed and that processes are in place to tackle the criminal and sexual exploitation of young people. Officers continue to support registered social landlords in tackling anti-social behaviour cases which in time should upskill partners to enable them to tackle ASB more effectively and improve data sharing and intelligence. The most recent meeting of this forum was 22 September 2022. More complex neighbour disputes are dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Officers also meet with the community mental health teams on a bi-monthly basis to discuss complex cases and support arrangements for vulnerable people. The partnership supported Neighbourhood Watch (NHW) throughout the pandemic and migrated members to Microsoft Teams. Hybrid meetings are now held with the meetings alternating between Maldon and Chelmsford with the last meeting being held in Maldon on 27 September 2022. Officers also attend Mid-Essex Stay Safe, Mid-Essex Children's Partnership Board (MECPB), Chelmsford & Maldon Behaviour and Attendance Partnership (BAP), Maldon Youth Strategy Group, Safer Essex, Essex Community Safety Network, County Prevent Group, Essex Contest Board, SIGCE, Essex CCTV User Group and the County Safeguarding Leads meeting.
- 3.3.3 The Community Safety Engagement Officer (CSEO) role for Maldon will be dedicated to improving engagement with our communities and will involve engagement on virtual platforms such as Facebook and Twitter. A copy of the Essex Police monthly newsletter was initially circulated to elected members and parishes and received good feedback. However, this moved to a weekly e-newsletter in August 2022: Dispatch, Maldon Edition. The CSEO works closely with CEOs and the tri-service role funded by police, fire, and the ambulance service. This work has involved the creation of a fraud aware booklet for distribution in rural communities, delivering safe and well inspections, supporting numerous events and recent partnership working in Burnham-on-Crouch, Southminster, Heybridge, Bradwell, Tollesbury and Heybridge to look at various areas of public concern.
- 3.3.4 Current concerns for the partnership hub focus on violence and vulnerability, and disruption of organised crime together with monitoring "hot spots" such as Maldon High Street, Promenade Park, Hythe Quay, and some of the parks across the district where young people are congregating and consuming alcohol and using nitrous oxide cannisters. The continued use of Operations Trespass, Aegis, Overwatch and Sceptre are proving successful and in recent months there have been significant arrests to disrupt both local and County Line drug networks. ECFRS has recently presented some case studies in relation to fire fatalities whereby the victims were living alone, socially isolated with hoarding tendencies and this is an area of work the partnership is keen to address by working with communities to help with early identification.
- 3.3.5 Crucial Crew was delivered to Year 6 primary school students in May 2022 with a mixture of face-to-face and virtual delivery using a provider called Tic Box Productions, this production and workshop focussed on exploitation and awareness around knife crime and drugs. The community safety team worked with partners to deliver a safety awareness event at Promenade Park which included a cycle marking

initiative on 8 April 2022. Similar events were held on 11 August and 31 August 2022 in Tollesbury and Burnham -on- Crouch. Officers from MDC, ECFR, Crimestoppers and Essex Watch all attended and there was some positive engagement with the public. A Senior Safety Silver Sunday event was organised on 3 October 2022 at Maldon Football Stadium for over 65s and over eighty persons attended this event. The event was delivered with the Safer Chelmsford Partnership, Essex Police, ECFRS, health providers, ECC Trading Standards and NHS East of England Ambulance Service, and a variety of contributing partners. Maldon Youth Strategy has funded a professional drama by a professional drama company to be delivered in both secondary schools. The drama: 'Unacceptable', focused on tackling sexism, sexual abuse, and sexual harassment against young women. The community safety and community engagement team are involved in several initiatives across the district that impact on community safety:

- Maldon Street Week was held on 29 July 5 August 2022.
- Public engagement events in Maldon, Heybridge, Tollesbury and Burnhamon-Crouch.
- Trucam is currently being delivered across 18 parishes at 45 different locations.
- PREVENT Duty met and scored 3 (standard met) by Home Office.
- Effective use and joint working using CCTV with annual compliance reported to Biometrics and Surveillance Camera Commissioner.
- Safeguarding awareness training delivered.
- Hate crime awareness sessions in Burnham-on-Crouch and supporting hate crime awareness week.
- Joint patrols with Essex Police and the Tri Service Officer to tackle community concerns.
- Officers have recently gone through the Essex Police Community Safety Accreditation Scheme (CSAS) reaccreditation process and are now accredited until 31 January 2025.
- Close working relationship with Essex Police Rural Engagement Team (RET) to tackle issues such as fly tipping and unlicensed waste carriers.
- Partnership working with Essex Police in the form of joint patrols to encourage responsible dog ownership.
- Supporting Coffee with Cops.
- Joint patrols with ECC Youth Service at key locations.
- Intelligence sharing with secondary schools to safeguard any identified vulnerable persons.
- Engagement with youths through the Just Play football initiative.
- J9 Domestic abuse awareness training supporting domestic abuse awareness week.
- Healthy relationships and exploitation awareness sessions for schools.

4. CONCLUSION

4.1 That Members note the proposed priorities for 2022 / 23 and progress on the community safety partnership. The shared working arrangements between Maldon and Chelmsford continue to support local priorities, high level policing priorities and the priorities of the revised PFCC plan and has strengthened with the co-location of the community policing team in March 2019 and additional policing resources in town centres and rural areas. The increased footprint for the community policing team at MDC offices will strengthen this partnership further. Maldon CSP remains efficient and responsive to emerging issues and more importantly positions itself strongly for

future funding arrangements with the Essex PFCC, statutory partners, and local / national initiatives.

5.1 These priorities contribute to the Council's vision of "Through our projects, actions, communication, partnerships and policies we will work to support our communities, the health and well-being of our residents, and to provide safe and clean places to live in and enjoy."
