The Chairman welcomed everyone present and went through some general housekeeping arrangements for the meeting.

313. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

RESOLVED that the Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 10 March 2022 be approved.

317. MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

The Committee received the report of the Director of Service Delivery reporting the progress of activities undertaken by Maldon Community Safety Partnership (CSP) since the last meeting held on 10 March 2022.

The most recent Essex Police performance summary (to September 2022) was attached as Appendix 1 to the report.

Members noted the continued good work of the CSP and the liaison it had with Essex Police and other statutory partners. The current Maldon CSP 'Plan on a Page' for 2022 / 23 was attached as Appendix 2.

The Community Safety Manager took Members through the report and provided additional information and further detail. A lengthy discussion ensued during which a number of points were raised and in response the following information was provided:

- Priority two related to driving down Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) in public places and incorporated improvement to visibility. Members were advised how some initiatives such as a youth worker around Tollesbury were proving more effective than if were carried out by the Police.
- The Community Safety Partnership was dealing with ASB matters such as young people causing problems, neighbour nuisance etc. A lot of the recently ASB complaints probably related to Covid breaches. The Officer advised that this should still be an area of priority but further analysis of the data for this year was required.
- In response to questions relating to Rural Crime the Community Safety Manager suggested that Chief Inspector Terry Balding be invited to attend the March meeting of the Committee to provide a presentation on this subject. It was noted that Officer numbers on the Rural Crime Team had doubled over the last two years which had enabled greater communication with businesses such as farms.
- It was acknowledged there had been an increase in Hate Crime, however this could relate to increased reporting following recent promotions. These figures were monitored and discussed with community groups. The Officer agreed to undertake further analysis the data and victims.
- The decision by Heybridge Parish Council to end their contract with the Community Enforcement Team was mentioned and Members were reassured that this would not impact the Community Safety Partnership.
- Safer Essex Partnership were responsible for traffic enforcement and the Community Safety Manager provided details of a recent event that had taken place in Maldon. He agreed to get further statistics on this and take on board the comments raised regarding speeding specifically in Wickham Bishops. If local communities were interested in undertaking a community speedwatch the Officer advised this could be raised with him outside of the meeting.
- Sergeant (Sgt) Dalby explained that if there were Members of the Public that
 wished to become part of a community speedwatch they could sign up to be
 trained to use the speed unit. He also reported that during Covid the
 community speedwatch had been withdrawn. However, this was now being
 reintroduced with the training of new operatives being undertaken.
- A Member referred to the recent work undertaken in relation to hare coursing and thanks were expressed. The Officer noted the thanks given and advised he would feed this back to the relevant team.

The Chairman thanked the Community Safety Manager for his presentation.

RESOLVED that the current progress of the initiatives undertaken by the Community Safety Partnership be noted.

318. POLICE PERFORMANCE UPDATE

The Chairman introduced Acting Chief Inspector (ACI) Kelly Thurston and Sergeant (Sqt) Matt Dalby, from Essex Police.

Sgt Dalby advised Members' that he was the new Maldon Town team Sergeant and addressed the Committee drawing Members' attention to the Essex Police Performance Summary report, appended to Agenda Item 6 – Maldon District Community Safety Partnership Update. He then provided Members with a detailed presentation and highlighted the following areas:

- **Crime** There had been an increase in crime across the Maldon District of 5.2% overall with an increase of 7.7% in victim crime and reduction in state crime of 6.2%. There were a number of areas that had seen a reduction in crime with Anti-Social Behaviour being down by 61.8%.
- TRI Service Officer The Maldon District was supported by a TRI Services
 Officer who visited rural communities offering advice on crime prevention, fire
 prevention and was also a trained first responder and working alongside the
 Police Rural Engagement Team. The Officer had acquired some great
 intelligence through his visits to local communities resulting in the successful
 executive of search warrants along with reductions in hare coursing and
 unauthorised encampments.
- Dedicated Schools Operation Members were advised how Community
 Policing Teams were engaging with local Primary and Secondary schools which
 included dealing with any local parking or driving issues. The new Maldon
 Town Team were also jointly working with the Community Engagement Team
 and Enforcement Operations Manager on this issue.
- The Maldon Town Team was now operating from the Maldon Police Station and expected to be at full strength by December 2022 with a team of one sergeant and five constables.

Following the update and in response to questions from the Committee, ACI Thurston and Sgt Dalby provided the following information:

- Crime In response to comments regarding the increase in crime rate, Members were advised how crime could only be solved if the evidence was there to support it. The Police did experience a lot of cases where crime was reported but people were then not wanting to engage it the process / provide evidence meaning that the particular case was not marked as a solved crime. Further examples were given, and it was highlighted how some cases of reported crime may have a positive outcome but would not show in the solved rate because the crime was not solved e.g. a crime committed by a child was directed to another service such as the Youth Offending Team. It was reported that a further rise in crime was expected because of the cost-of-living crisis. In response to a request for data around positive outcomes, ACI Thurston advised that she would see if it was something they were able to produce.
- Essex Police policy was for all burglaries to be attended by a Police Constable.
- Staffing Members were reminded of the uplift in staff to the Maldon Town Centre team and that the levels for response teams was not changing. The Community Policing Team worked out of Chelmsford and covered both that area and Maldon.
- **Schools** Within the Local Policing Area there were 90 primary and just under 30 secondary schools. The Police were keen to interact and support all schools

but the level of support from schools differed greatly. ACI Thurston advised that they were looking to speak with Secondary school headteachers to highlight the benefits of schools having an open-door policy with the Police, moving away from the common negativity regarding Police attending schools. Essex Police were currently running a school project in Chelmsford called 'Play as One', running for ten-weeks, an Officer would be assigned to the school to engage with children identified as vulnerable (for a variety of reasons) and as an incentive at the end the children got to play football with a Chelmsford footballer, for example. ACI Thurston explained that although in its infancy it was hoped to get this rolled out to all schools from 2023.

• Knife crime – The knife bin outside the Council offices continued to be well used. A smaller knife bin (that houses a wheelie bin) had been acquired in conjunction with the Violence and Vulnerability Team. This smaller bin would be installed in January 2023 at Longfield.

Councillor M S Heard proposed that the Committee invite the Police, Crime and Fire Commissioner to attend the March 2023 meeting of this Committee. This was duly seconded and agreed.

The Chairman thanked Acting Chief Inspector Thurston and Sergeant Dalby for attending the meeting and their presentation.

There being no other items of business the Chairman closed the meeting at 9.33 pm.

The chairman welcomed everyone present and went over some general housekeeping arrangements for the meeting.

611. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors B S Beale MBE and V J Bell.

612. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

RESOLVED that the Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 24 January 2023 be approved and confirmed.

613. DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST

Councillor M S Heard disclosed that his son is a serving Police Officer and also a member of the Police and Crime Panel.

614. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

There was none.

615. MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

The Committee received the report of the Director of Service Delivery reporting the progress of activities undertaken by Maldon Community Safety Partnership (CSP) since the last meeting held on 20 October 2022.

The most recent Essex Police performance summary (to January 2023) was attached as Appendix 1 to the report.

Members noted the continued good work of the CSP and the liaison it had with Essex Police and other statutory partners.

The Community Safety Manager took Members through the report and provided additional information and further detail. A lengthy discussion ensued during which a number of points were raised and in response the following information was provided:

- Priority four related to promoting road safety and challenging irresponsible driving. The Community Safety Manager (CSM) suggested that Mr Pipe from Essex Police attend the next Committee Meeting to give greater detail on the work being carried out.
- Priority Two related driving down anti-social behaviour in public places with an
 emphasis on youth nuisance and improving partnership visibility. The CSM
 made members aware that from a District point of view, the reduction of 42%
 wasn't highly visible due to previous stats being high due to COVID breaches
 and hoped that by this time next year there should be a true representation of
 statistics.
- In response to questions regarding greater clarity around statistics the CSM suggested it would be a good idea for more analysis to be completed as this would highlight areas that need attention going forward.
- It was acknowledged that fly tipping had seen an increase in the District and that the environmental agency is still trying to tackle this.
- In response to questions around point 3.3.5 a new knife amnesty bin was installed at Promenade Park on 16 January 2023. The CSM ensured Members that he would obtain local figures from the Police Commissioners Office regarding how much weapon waste was collected from the bin when it was collected and moved from outside the Council Offices.
- Members were made aware of the work being carried out in schools in the
 District. The CSM wanted Members to know of his intentions to bring forward a
 strategy around violence towards women and girls to Maldon schools in the
 future.
- The Director of Service Delivery responded Members regarding potential fly tipping as a result of the new Essex County Council recycling center scheme and reassured Members that CCTV is used near frequented fly tipping sites to catch offenders.
- The Director of Service Delivery and CSM reassured Members that the Community Engagement team and this service is offered out to Parishes and whether a Parish is using those services the CSP will still operate within those areas.
- Members Commended the work of Community Engagement Officer Police Constable Rosie Smith.

The Chairman thanked the Community Safety Manager for his presentation.

RESOLVED that the current progress of the initiatives undertaken by the Community Safety Partnership be noted.

616. POLICE PERFORMANCE UPDATE

The Chairman introduced Chief Inspector Paul Ballard (CI) from Essex Police.

CI Ballard provided Members with a detailed presentation and highlighted the following areas:

- Foot patrols in the Maldon District The Community Policing Team and the Community Safety Engagement Officers are regularly patrolling the District on foot enabling them to engage with members of the public and showing a greater visible presence.
- Community Engagement Essex Police have been working closely with partner agencies at Community Engagement events in the District offering crime prevention advice and materials in various locations around the District. They have also work in partnership with Maldon District Council to run bike marking events and '999 days' to engage with the public.
- School and nursery visits to engage with the younger members of the community Essex Police have been attending many schools and nurseries in the District to engage with young people to explain the role of a Police Officer and to provide safety advice, making special efforts with those children that are about to enter year seven in school.
- Enforcement Officers have used their Stop and Search Powers to tackle violent crime and have seized multiple weapons that were being carried on the street. Multiple drink, drug and uninsured drivers have also been arrested in the District.
- **Speed Checks** These are being increased in various locations across the District and have engaged with the public and local Parish Councils regarding speeding concerns and act on this.
- Rural Engagement Team Patrols The Rural Engagement Team has been loaned a New Holland tractor by New Holland Agriculture and Ernest Doe -Agriculture. They have been engaging with rural issues such as hare coursing, rural road safety, unauthorised encampments and wildlife and heritage crime.

Following the presentation and in response to questions from the Committee, CI Ballard provided the following information:

- Hare Coursing Essex Police take this Crime very seriously and are working hard to reduce this further. This has been completed in part thanks to the use of drones, having a better working relationship with neighbouring forces, and showing the hare coursing community that we take a hard stance against this Crime in Essex
- **Drug Offences** The CI clarified that the statistics shown in Appendix 1 run from January to January in their respective years. He then went on to confirm that the increase seen in respect to around this crime was a direct result of proactive policing (stop and search).
- Manning Levels Development The CI was not aware of any reductions in Community Support Officers (CSO) and the last reduction was in 2015/2016 and Essex Police are currently recruiting to maintain numbers not to increase. In

relation to resourcing numbers there is an algorithm that is used based around the Census information to allocate Police to a certain area. CI went on to say that he wasn't aware of an immediate increase in resource to support the increase of population due to the new housing development in Heybridge, but when the next Census is taken this should reflect in the algorithm.

- **Stop and search** The CI responded to the question of individual statistics being shared with the Committee, stating that he would be more than happy to provide this information once he could obtain it.
- Modern Slavery The CI made Members aware that Police and other agencies may not publicise their activity overtly as they may alert perpetrators, however, there is work ongoing and Essex Police make sure to respond to information given to them.
- Residential Burglary CI Ballard ensured Members that this is one of the priorities on Essex Polices Force Plan, and Officers attend every burglary, however if the homeowner isn't present then they will attend when they are.
- Parking on pavements The CI informed Members that Essex Police don't currently police parking as they don't have the legislation to do this, however for persistent offenders this may be able to be addressed under the ASB act. The CI went on to explain that SEPP are the primary agency that respond to this issue and Essex Police will ensure that they are utilising this partnership to its fullest potential to address this. The Director of Service Delivery suggested he send an invitation to SEPP to attend the next Meeting in October, Members agreed.

CI Ballard responded to Councillor C Mayes question around the Herbert Protocol, confirming that it is a set of procedures and processes used by Police in order to improve response and better support vulnerable people in the Community. Further explanation was given around the protocol regarding the processes involved and ways of locating missing persons.

The Chairman thanked Chief Inspector Ballard for attending the meeting and his presentation.

The meeting closed at 9.14 pm.

MALDON DISTRICT COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP UPDATE

1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 Members are asked to note the progress of activities undertaken by the Maldon Community Safety Partnership (CSP) since the last meeting held on 2 March 2023.

2. RECOMMENDATION

That Members review and comment on the current progress of the initiatives undertaken by the partnership to date.

3. SUMMARY OF KEY ISSUES

3.1 **Statutory Duties**

- 3.1.1 Officers are currently working on the strategic assessment, and this will be presented to the Responsible Authorities Group on 14 March 2024 for endorsement. This will involve a data review, crime risk matrix scoring and analysis of perception data. Headline priorities are likely to remain the same as the previous year with some changes to the narrative based on the current risks. Proposed priorities will reflect priorities already identified in the revised Police and Crime Plan, the Essex Crime Prevention Strategy, Maldon District Council's Corporate Plan (2023-27) and the current Essex Police Strategic Assessment. Officers are also working on Operation Minerva data (female victimisation) to establish areas of risk within the district and the new mapping tool for reporting unsafe areas for women which may also impact on priorities. The joint strategic needs assessment that is now a requirement under the Serious Violence Duty will also be completed to support work on associated crimes.
- 3.1.2 The current priorities are highlighted on the Maldon District Council (MDC) website. It should be noted that reducing reoffending remains a statutory function for all community safety partnerships and is embedded in the priorities listed below.
 - Tackling crime and reducing reoffending (with an emphasis on serious violence, crime, gangs, drug trafficking and high harm offences);
 - Driving down anti-social behaviour in public places (with an emphasis on youth nuisance and improving partnership visibility);
 - Identifying and supporting vulnerable people (with an emphasis on domestic abuse, violence against women and girls, social isolation, suicide prevention, poor mental health and hate crime);
 - Increase confidence in identifying and reducing rural crime;

Our Vision: Where Quality of Life Matters

- Promoting road safety and challenging irresponsible driving.
- 3.1.3 It should be noted that the activities of the Partnership have recently been subject to the audit process again in 2022 and the report was presented at the March 2023 Performance, Audit and Governance Committee. All actions from this audit are complete.
- 3.1.4 The current Essex Police Maldon performance figures for the rolling year to 31 July 2023 (compared to the same period last year) showed a decrease in all crime by 11.9% (455 less offences) and a decrease in Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) by 43.4% (213 less incidents). It should be noted that there has been a decrease in all crime in Essex by 5.1% with a decrease in ASB by 31.5%. A summary of the crime profile for Maldon will be presented at the meeting by Chief Inspector Paul Ballard. A copy of the Essex Police force performance summary for the county is attached as APPENDIX 1.
- 3.1.5 Officers continue to work with the Essex Police to ensure that local risks are addressed. The Community Safety Manager chairs the Essex County Prevent Group and attends the Essex Contest Board. The most recent Counter Terrorism Local Profile (CTLP) briefing (Quarter 1) was on 12 September 2023 and strategic members have been briefed on current risks. New guidance with a toolkit for local authorities was published on 7 September 2023: Prevent duty toolkit for local authorities GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)
- 3.1.6 New duties that will impact on the work of the partnership will be the Protect Duty (Martyn's Law). We anticipate that this will receive Royal Assent in Autumn 2023 with the duty becoming live early in 2024. Martyn's Law will impose requirements on premises and events to increase their preparedness for, and protection from, a terrorist attack. The law will require premises to take proportionate steps, depending on the size and nature of the activities that take place. This will be based on qualifying premises and capacity thresholds: standard tier (capacity of 100 or more, enhanced tier (800 or more) and places of worship (standard tier regardless of capacity).

3.2 Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner (PFCC) Update

- 3.2.1 The partnership continues to support the priorities identified in the refreshed Police and Crime Plan which was extended until 2024. The next public meeting for Maldon is on Monday 9 October 2023 at Maldon United Reform Church at 19.00hrs.
- 3.2.2 Works continue with several multi-agency groups that support this work locally and across Essex. The Maldon representative for the Police Fire and Crime Panel is Councillor Simon Burwood. The Office of the Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner (OPFCC) confirmed that core funding for Maldon in 2023 / 24 was £12,527 and the necessary funding forms were completed and returned as part of the funding agreement.

3.3 Community Safety Partnership Hub and Progress Update

3.3.1 The CSP Hub for Chelmsford and Maldon was re-launched on 5 July 2023 following recent discussions. The new style meetings will be held fortnightly on Wednesday from 09.30-10.30hrs, meet bi-monthly and has a tasking process which links to the priorities of the CSP. The new process will include a tasking update from the Community Policing Team (CPT) Sargeant (Sgt), licensing, a two-week forecast, identified hotspots, patrol plans, communications, complex cases, and organised crime groups. Fortnightly tasking with Essex Police and the Community Safety Team

is also held on Tuesdays. There is an individual action plan for Maldon CSP plus a tasking update which is monitored to ensure that partner actions are completed and performance managed.

3.3.4 Current concerns for the Partnership hub focus on violence and vulnerability, and disruption of organised crime together with monitoring "hot spots" such as Maldon High Street, Promenade Park, Hythe Quay, and some of the parks across the district where young people are congregating, consuming alcohol and misusing drugs. Locations of concern that have been highlighted and the subject of partnership visits in recent months include Tollesbury, Southminster, Bradwell and Heybridge. Partnership operations are proving successful and in recent months there have been significant arrests to disrupt both local and County Line drug networks. Officers are also dealing with some complex antisocial behaviour complaints where mediation has been offered to parties to resolve the situation.

3.3.5 Current project works include:

- Healthy relationships and exploitation awareness sessions for schools in May 2023.
- Safe, Well and Secure visits delivered with Essex County Fire and Rescue Service (ECFRS) between 23 - 25 May 2023 (1,499 doors knocked, 512 faceto-face contacts, 95 safe and well referrals and 117 home fire safety checks).
- Maldon Street Week was held on 27 May 3 June 2023.
- Crucial Crew was delivered to Year 6 students in June 2023 theatre production on exploitation and knife crime awareness.
- Public engagement events in Maldon, Heybridge, Tollesbury and Burnhamon-Crouch (999 days).
- Senior Safety event delivered for over 65's delivered on 2 October 2023.
- Trucam is currently being delivered across 18 parishes at 45 different locations and a new unit has been ordered to improve capability.
- PREVENT Duty met and scored 3 (standard met) by Home Office in April 2023.
- Effective use and joint working using CCTV with annual compliance reported to Biometrics and Surveillance Camera Commissioner.
- Safeguarding awareness training delivered.
- Hate crime awareness sessions in Burnham-on-Crouch and supporting hate crime awareness week.
- Joint patrols with Essex Police and the Tri Service Officer to tackle community concerns.
- Close working relationship with Essex Police Rural Engagement Team (RET) to tackle issues such as fly tipping and unlicensed waste carriers.
- Partnership working with Essex Police in the form of joint patrols to encourage responsible dog ownership.

- Joint patrols with Essex County Council Youth Service at key locations.
- Intelligence sharing with secondary schools to safeguard any identified vulnerable persons.
- Engagement with youths through the Just Play football initiative.

 J9 Domestic abuse awareness training supporting domestic abuse awareness week.

4. CONCLUSION

4.1 That Members note the priorities for 2023 / 24 and progress on the CSP. The shared working arrangements between Maldon and Chelmsford continue to support local priorities, high level policing priorities and the priorities of the revised PFCC plan and has strengthened with the co-location of the CPT and additional policing resources in town centres and rural areas. The increased footprint for the CPT at MDC offices will strengthen this partnership further. Maldon CSP remains efficient and responsive to emerging issues and more importantly positions itself strongly for future funding arrangements with the Essex PFCC, statutory partners, and local / national initiatives.
