Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

- 1 That no supply of alcohol may be made under the Premises Licence:-
 - a) At a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence
 - b) At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended.
- 2 That every supply of alcohol under the Premises Licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.
- 3 Where a Premises Licence or Club Premises Certificate authorises the exhibition of films, the Licence or Certificate must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with these paragraphs.

Where the film classification body is specified in the Licence or Certificate, unless paragraph (b) below applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation by that body.

Where,

- a) The film classification body is not specified in the Licence or Certificate
- b) The Licensing Authority has notified the holder of the Licence or the Club which holds the Certificate that this paragraph applies to the film in question,

Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the Licensing Authority

In these paragraphs,
 'children' means persons aged under 18, and
 'film classification body' means the person or persons designated as the authority under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1 Persons who appear to be under the age of 18 years shall be required to produce proof of age by way of one of the following:

- a recognised proof of age card accredited under the British Retail Consortiums Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS)
- photo driving licence
- passport
- Citizen card supported by the Home Office
- Official ID card issued by HM Forces or European Union bearing a photograph and birth of the holder

2 No films or videos of any description will be shown so that they can be viewed by persons under the age of any applicable BBFC / Local Authority Certification.

3 There shall be no entry or re-entry on Fridays and Saturdays after 23:30

4 The car park to the premises shall be patrolled regularly at intervals after dusk and have adequate lighting.

5 All exits and escape routes to those exits (including external escape routes) from the premises shall be provided with non-slip even surfaces and shall be maintained in good repair, correct working order and kept free from all obstructions when the public are on the premises. External escape routes shall also be kept free from ice and snow. And shall be clearly marked.

6 All fire safety equipment to be maintained or replaced according to the fire safety certificate or by any manufacturer's guidelines.

7 For the prevention of Public Nuisance the following must be conformed to:-

- i) Live entertainment to cease 1 hour before closing.
- ii) Staff to monitor noise levels of live and recorded music to ensure it does not cause disturbance to neighbouring properties.
- iii) All windows and doors to be closed when any entertainment is being provided
- iiii) Staff to ensure customers leaving premises do so with due consideration to neighbouring properties.
- iv) The garden is to be vacated by 23:00hrs.

8 All staff employed on the premises will have undergone training with regard their responsibilities in recognising drink and drug abuse

9 Children under the age of 18 years will be accompanied by a responsible adult.

10 Children under the age of 16 to leave the restaurant area by 23:00Hrs and the rest of the premises by 22:00Hrs.
