Objection to the application of a variation to the existing Premises License on the Promenade Park (Prevention of Public Nuisance - Noise and Vibrations in a residential area)

I have noticed Steven Cochrane IN THE PARK CONCERT LTD has applied for a variation to the premises license on the Promenade Park to extend the hours on a Friday from 2pm until 6pm. Giving new times of 2pm until 10:30pm.

These concerts are being held on the edge of the park and in a residential area. The noise level and vibrations from these events is so loud that my front door vibrates and it is impossible to do anything inside my home like listen to the television or simply make a phone call. You have received many previous complaints regarding the noise level and the harm this causes to myself and other residents trying to enjoy a peaceful life.

The noise level and vibrations are unbearable inside my home on Park Drive when these concerts take place. And extending this would cause additional and unnecessary distress and harm.

You have received many previous complaints regarding the noise levels, vibrations from the sound stage, and the placement of the stage under this current license (opposite houses along Park Drive) and I ask you consider the residents along Park Drive before you make this bad situation worse by extending the hours.
