# DISCRETIONARY COUNCIL TAX REBATE SCHEME

# 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

For Members to approve the Discretionary Council Tax Rebate Scheme at **APPENDIX 1**. The scheme is fully funded by Central Government.

### 2. **RECOMMENDATION**

That the proposed Discretionary Council Tax Rebate Scheme at **APPENDIX 1** be approved.

### 3. SUMMARY OF KEY ISSUES

- 3.1 In addition to a mandatory rebate scheme to help provide support for rising energy bills, the government has also allocated funds for a discretionary scheme. The use of these funds is to be determined by individual Councils in line with national guidance.
- 3.2 Funding allocations have been calculated based on the index of multiple deprivation and an estimated number of local council tax support claimants in bands E to H. This has resulted in Maldon being allocated £132k.
- 3.3 The mandatory scheme covered homes in bands A-D, providing a payment of £150. The discretionary scheme proposes allocations of £150 to those homes in bands A-H who are in receipt of Council Tax reduction.
- 3.4 In addition we are proposing that the balance of the funding is dispersed by way of a one off, equal value 'top up' payment to all recipients of the £150 payment (mandatory and discretionary schemes)

### 4. CONCLUSION

4.1 The proposed Discretionary Council Tax Rebate Scheme at **APPENDIX 1** will enable additional financial support for eligible residents.

### 5. IMPACT ON STRATEGIC THEMES

5.1 The Discretionary Council Tax Rebate Scheme will enable the granting of additional money to residents which will support the Council's goal of "prosperity".
