

NEW CODE OF CONDUCT - REGISTER OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS

GENERAL NOTICE OF REGISTERABLE INTERESTS

I, Councillor Oluwamayowa Ayodele of Mayland Parish Council set out below under the appropriate headings my interests, which I am required to declare under the Localism Act 2011 and the Council's Code of Conduct. Where I have no such interests I have stated "NONE".

Disclosable pecuniary interests

Members are required to register not only their own interests under this heading but also those of their husband or wife, civil partner or of any person with whom they are living as if husband and wife or civil partners when such interests are known by them.
